My friend, Dave Rohr, was here this summer, and we sowed much and in many places. We went door-to-door passing out invitations to a Bible correspondence course and/or New Testaments in many of the village-suburbs of Cheboksary. Several evenings we went out in Cheboksary witnessing to people on the street. Please join us in prayer that there would be great harvests to come because of this planting.

The Lord blessed me in the purchase of a new car for my ministry here. Unfortunately, it was at the cost of a missionary family that left Russia to return to the United States. This family lived about 100 miles from me in a city called Kazan. I was sorry to hear of his decision to return to the states, but was blessed with several of their house wares that I needed and it was helpful to them to sell their vehicle. They were a blessing to me in my ministry here, and I will miss the fellowship that we had together.

I have started a new ministry. I am conducting a English Kid's Club for children that would like to practice English. The class involves the use of Bible lessons and games to teach children about Christ while helping them improve their English. This ministry came about because of many school kids who wanted my help with English. My goal in this is to reach the children and through them their parents, in manner similar to Sunday School in America. I ask for your prayers for this ministry so that many new people would hear the gospel through these classes.

I would like to thank you again for all the prayers and concern for my health these last few months. I have healed from my hernia surgery and can now lift heavy items and work on things that I had not been able to. I am feeling better than I have in a long time, and I give God all the glory and praise. Praise the Lord!
